Subject: PROTECTIVE MEASURES AGAINST THE NEW CORONAVIRUS

I write to advise that Management of Mulungushi University is aware of the coronavirus (COVID-19) which affects all of us globally. I therefore urge the community to diligently pray to God Almighty to intervene in this situation.

I also request you members of staff and students to stay aware of the latest information on the COVID-19 outbreak. This information is available on the websites for Ministry of Health (www.moh.gov.zm) and the World Health Organisation (www.who.org). You are requested to follow the guidance outlined.

To prevent COVID-19, it is safest to avoid physical contact when greeting. Safe greeting should now include a wave, a nod or a bow. You are advised to maintain at least one metre (3 feet) distance between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing, avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth and regularly wash your hands.

If you have fever, cough and difficulty in breathing, seek medical care immediately.

The most important of all, is to earnestly pray to God Almighty for his intervention.

BE SAFE FROM CORONAVIRUS INFECTION. BE SMART AND INFORM YOURSELF ABOUT IT AND BE KIND AND SUPPORT ONE ANOTHER.

In the meantime, Management will continue coming up with strategies and follow Government guidelines in combating the coronavirus epidemic.
